Budget 2020 – Key Points

Following the latest Budget from the government, here are our key takeouts for businesses and accountancy use:

- Statutory sick pay is available from day one for those advised to self-isolate with Coronavirus, even if they are not showing any symptoms. The government will meet the cost of this for up to 14 days, for companies with up to 250 employees.
- More help for the self-employed through a £500m welfare boost and a hardship fund.
- 3. Government loans are available to help small and medium sized businesses.
- 4. Business rates are abolished for the retail, leisure and hospitality sector for those with premises whose rateable value is less than £51,000.
- 5. A £3,000 grant to businesses eligible for small business rates relief.
- 6. Fuel, beer, wine and spirit duties are frozen.
- 7. A business rates discount for pubs, of £5,000.00, only for this year.
- 8. National insurance threshold to rise from £8,632.00 to £9,500.00
- 9. Corporation tax remains at 19% and will not be reduced to 17% as previously indicated.
- The lifetime allowance for Entrepreneurs Relief will be reduced from £10 million to £1 million.
- 11. VAT on digital publications including books, newspapers, magazines and academic journals will be abolished from December.
